The data of Paul's letters and of the Acts are not identical. The letters, however, are the primary sources for the author's life and the Luke's story in the Acts is only a secondary source, so that in cases of factual dispute preference should be given to the letters.

Figure 1. gives the visual display of the most frequently occurring words in Paul's letters. In Romans and Galatians, the words law, faith, righteousness, spirit, sin, flesh are emphasized. In pastoral letters, the word good stands out; it is used to describe good work(s), good conscience.

The use of the definite article, the, before spirit and Anointed follows Paul's usage as closely as possible. In the first century, when Paul wrote his letters, all Greek letters were written as capitals. The distinction between uppercase and lowercase letters had not yet been invented.

genuinely Pauline by early Christian writers, but for two hundred years scholars have debated their authenticity.

In Rome Saint Paul wrote his letters to the Philippians (with gratitude for the financial aid sent to him with Epaphroditus), to the Colossians, to the Ephesians, and to Philemon, a citizen of Colossus (concerning his slave Onesimus, who had run away).

ACTS AND THE PAULINE EPISTLES

The epistle to Philemon is unique in Paul's letter in that it was largely written as a response to a single situation. Specifically, Philemon was a wealthy member of the Colossian church. He had a slave named Onesimus who ran away. Strangely, Onesimus ministered to Paul while the apostle was imprisoned in Rome.

Overview of the Pauline Epistles of the New Testament

Pauline epistles. The Pauline epistles are usually placed between the Acts of the Apostles and the general epistles in modern editions. Most Greek manuscripts, however, place the General epistles first, and a few minuscules (175, 325, 336, and 1424) place the Pauline epistles at the end of the New Testament.

The Letter to the Philippians. This letter is one of those (like Colossians, Ephesians and Philemon) written while Paul was in captivity. It is not certain whether this was in Rome or Ephesus, and this would offer dates of either 62AD or 56AD. Philippians is one of the least doctrinal letters but contains a beautiful Christological hymn.
